The curriculum nurtures engagement, curiosity and innovation, brings learning to life in meaningful ways, and really makes an impact. All year groups went on trips to help them enhance their learning and have hands on experience. Children enjoyed the trips and the benefit was evident.





At Tarbiyyah we believe "not all classrooms have four walls". Pupils at Tarbiyyah are given opportunities to learn in different settings and environments.
