Year 1s becoming paleontologists for the day in their dinosaur workshop.



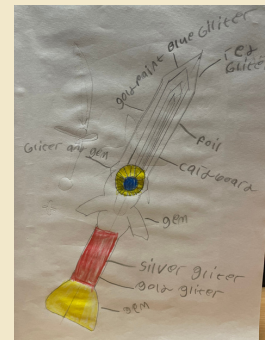
Year 2 getting stuck into art with some fantastic clay modelling.
